Light In The Forest

With my rear deck facing directly into the forest I have observed and appreciated things about the forest I never knew quite the same way in the past. I've always been at home in the forest and deeply appreciative of all things about the forest. Over the years I've accumulated and enjoyed a wide variety of books and articles

about the forest. Reading the woods became an avocation of mine. Learning how to identify and know the particulars about the different native trees along the East Coast forest and mountains became a lifelong joy. In short, I love the forest and all that is within it. Over the last 25 years living backed up to the Patuxent River Watershed I have learned new things about the forest and reached new levels of joy as I watch life unfold in the forest that surrounds us.

Among the things that I have had the time and opportunity to observe is the role of sunlight in the forest. Light is always a part of the ongoing day in the forest. Whether it is the absence of sunlight in the middle of storms or the presence of light as the early morning unfolds or the quiet departure of light as the day ends or in the middle of the daylight in the forest is an amazing thing.

We often don't take the time to notice all the different ways light unfolds in the forest. Sometimes a single ray of light will illuminate a sliver of the trees or even just one tree. Other times the forest is bathed in sunlight. As the light arrives in the morning it plays tricks on my eyes as it begins ever so small but continues to unfold. As the light recedes in the evening it is a gradual departure from light to dark and new scenes come into play. Sometimes a ray of light will surprise me as it spackles upon the trees or pops up here and there or on the forest floor. It's amazing treat to enjoy all the ways sun light plays out in the forest.

There's another kind of light that is even more amazing than the sunlight in the forest. The Bible refers to it often. It is the kind of light in which we live our daily lives. It is the kind of light that shines in our heart and reflects on our face. It is the light behind our smiles. It is the light that plays out in our words and even more importantly in our spirit. Call it the light of God or the light of the Holy Spirit or the light of our own soul but by whatever name we call it the light within is shines or doesn't every day in who we are and how we live.

The Old Testament and the New Testament alike are filled with references about how the light of God shines through people and call us all to live in His light. How does the light of God play out in your life? Much like the sunlight of the forest the inner light within us plays out in lots of different and amazing ways. We are called by faith to live in the light and come out of the darkness. We are called to walk in the light and not hide in darkness. That light within us plays out differently for every one of us. It is as varied and nuanced as the sunlight of the forest.

How do you live in the light? What are the unique ways the light of God come to life throughout the day, day in and day out in your own life? In a world of growing darkness be the light!

We entered into a contract with McCarthy Landscaping for snow removal on the sidewalks. While expensive we simply didn't get enough volunteers to continue doing it ourselves.


We have had several large building expenses but due to your generosity are able to keep our building in excellent condiion.
