Sunday, June the second marks the beginning of my 52nd year as the minister at Aspen Hill Christian Church. It's our 51st anniversary. That's amazing. It's an accomplishment few pastors and churches ever see. I never imagined I would see such a time. Fifty one years in a relationship in which we have all changed, seen things come and go, enjoyed good times and lived through bad times not to mention hard times.

I never expected to be here for the bulk of my career in ministry. I remember we almost didn't accept the call to come here because we couldn't find a house we could afford. We looked for two days and found nothing we liked that we could afford. On the day we were going back to Augusta our realtor said he had one more place for us to look it. We agreed to fit one more look into our schedule before departing. It wasn't our dream house, and it was a whopping \$40,500.00. It was two miles from the church which felt about right. It wasn't a bad little house, but the yard was terrible. The front yard was a small hill, and the back yard was a small triangular shaped yard which didn't suit us at all. But we liked it enough to take a chance on it. The church agreed to loan us the down payment at 8% interest. Howard Orebaugh found a mortgage loan for us, my dad a real estate lawyer took care of the settlement, and the rest was history.

My prevailing memories are deeply centered around the wonderful people God has blessed us with during all these years. I won't mention any by name as there are too many and I would no doubt fail to mention someone who was very special to us. Our friends in this church have been the greatest blessing God could ever had given us. We were given great neighbors who didn't attend church with us here but were the most wonderful friends we could have ever asked for. God called me to become in the Boy Scouts and more great people came into our lives through Scouting. God called me to become involved in Boys and Girls Clubs with coaching the sports I loved the most. He gave us a lifelong softball program to pour our hearts into, not to mention two knees, two shoulders and a ton of grit and grime.

Our family grew, we grew, the dream of building a new sanctuary, offices, meeting space and place of refuge unfolded over the years. We could never have asked for more. It hasn't always been wonderful days or times of joy. We've had our disagreements over the years. Some people have gone elsewhere while others, many others have come to add to the mix of great people in a great church.

I take this opportunity on our fifty-first anniversary to express our deep appreciation and genuine love for all of you in our church and in our community. Where will God call us into the next phase of our lives? I have no idea. But it appears to be pretty certain it will involve a cane, a stair climber, maybe a walker or two and a host of pills to deal with the joy of aging.

All I know is this. God has blessed us beyond words. You helped us raise our family and we are eternally grateful for your presence in our lives. God bless you all!


If you are interested in helping with our property ministry to keep our church facilities in good condition, please contact me (<u>johnsmallmb66@gmail.com</u>).

Repairing the Drain Disaster Hot Button Campaign Coming in June

We're trusting in the Lord's people to help us raise the necessary funds to pay back our Memorial Funds.
