A Season of Dryness



It's been a long dry season this Fall. With little to no rain in many weeks we are in something of a drought. It figures, I had my lawn aerated and over-seeded. The landscaper said it would be fine anyway as the morning dew would provide enough moisture for the seed to germinate. It's been so dry and so little dew that very little seed germinated.

There a lot more serious issues in life than our grass seed not growing and the subsequent waste of a growing season, not to mention the cost involved. But the dry season this fall, and lack of new seed growth is a metaphor for life itself, not just my life but all of our lives.

There are times in all of our lives when life is dry, hot and hard. There are times when the soil of our soul can become rock hard. The soil of our soul needs refreshing just as much as the ground needs water to provide new growth and new life. Sadly, there are seasons of life when our hearts begin to dry up and as we face deep losses or grief lingers and all the love and support of friends, family and church do little to help us. To be honest, this Fall has been just such a season for me and for my family. With the loss of my son-in law, Blake, my heart hurts deeply and my faith while still here isn't generating the kind of new growth and hope I would pray for. It's a dry season spiritually for me as well as physically in my yard. I try to help our beloved daughter and grandchildren but as hard as I try my words, and my love can only go so far.

Somehow we have to find our way through something we will never get over. Somehow we have to find ways to water our soul especially when the ground is hard, and we struggle with the deepest needs and questions our faith has to offer. Everyone goes through such times. I am always touched when I read that even the greatest saints and people of all time had to go through such times. Mother Theresa went through long, hard, lonely dry spells and somehow it brings me comfort to remember that in the midst of my own long, hard dry season.

We can't order faith to sustain us or comfort off the menu of life as if faith were a restaurant and we can order whatever we need or whatever we want, and the waiter or waitress will bring it to us. Life doesn't work that way. Even the great poet and songwriter Henry Wadsworth Longfellow went through such a time. One of the most beautiful hymns he ever wrote was "I Heard the Bells on Christmas Day." The song tells of the narrator hearing Christmas bells during the American Civil War while he despaired that hate is strong and mocks the song of peace on earth, good will to men." After a season of anguish and despondency the carol concludes with the bells ringing out "God is not dead, nor doth He sleep and that there ultimately peace on earth and good will to men will prevail.

Even in a season when my words of faith seem to mock my soul I believe in life eternal, and the love of God will always be with me. I can't say when I will hear the bells on Christmas day, but I have no doubt God, and my faith will not leave me alone and life will go on. That's what faith is. We plant the seeds of faith and hope even the dry seasons of life and anguish and despondency will give way to a newer and deeper faith.
